

Overall Achievement and Progress 2019-2020 results and performance.

Studio School KPIs

- 1. All students to secure appropriate destinations**
- 2. All students to make at least good progress**
- 3. Students to make good progress towards achieving their FFT50 estimates**

Context

There were 45 pupils in the 2019-20 Y11 cohort. The KS2 APS for this cohort was 25.7 which was well below the national average. The average reading age when this cohort joined us in autumn 2018 was 11 years and 11 months. There were 23 boys (51%) and 22 girls (49%). 19 pupils were SEND (42%), this is well above national average. 23 students were PP (51%) which is well above average. 4 students were Upper Prior Attainment (9%). 8 students were Middle Prior Attainment pupils (18%) and 30 students were Low Prior Attainment (67%). 3 students had no KS2 data (7%).

Progress against School KPIs

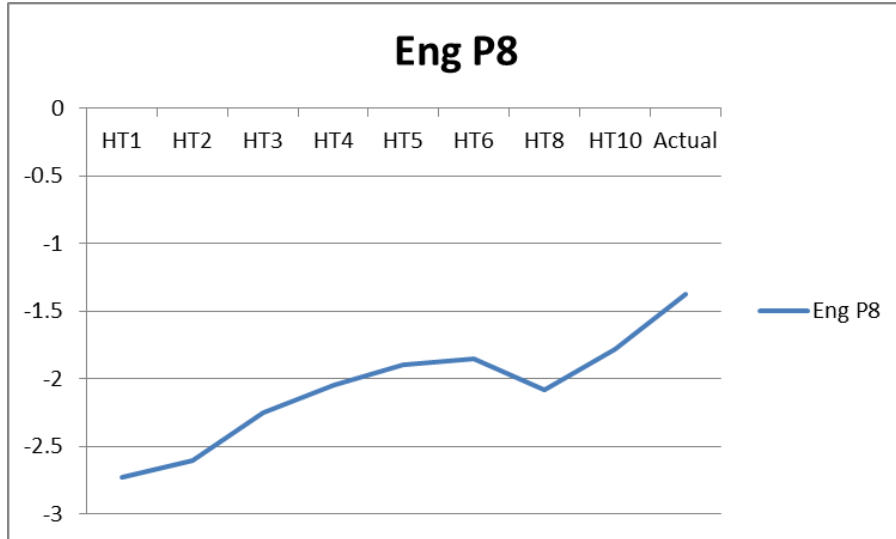
- (a) 100% of students have currently confirmed they have secured appropriate Post 16 destinations
- (b) During their 18 months at Stephenson Studio School 84% of students made one or more grades progress in maths, 53% of students made two or more grades progress.
- (c) During their 18 months at Stephenson Studio School 67% of students made one or more grades progress in English. 29% of students made two or more grades progress.
- (d) 82% were within one grade of achieving their FFT50 target in maths. 56% of students hit FFT50 targets.
- (e) 76% were within one grade of achieving their FFT50 target in English. 44% of students hit FFT50 targets.

Outcome Overview

- (a) 16% of students achieved a grade 4+ in both English and maths.
- (b) 29% of students achieved a grade 4+ in English. 13% of students achieved a 5+.
- (c) 31% of students achieved a grade 4+ in maths.
- (d) 27% of students gained a GCSE pass in science
- (a) 58% of students gained a L2 pass or better in BTEC Business.
- (b) 32% of students entered gained a GCSE pass in English Literature.
- (c) 100% of students gained a L2 pass in construction.
- (d) 88% of students gained a L1 pass in Hair and Beauty.
- (e) 83% of students gained a L1 pass in Motor Vehicle.

English

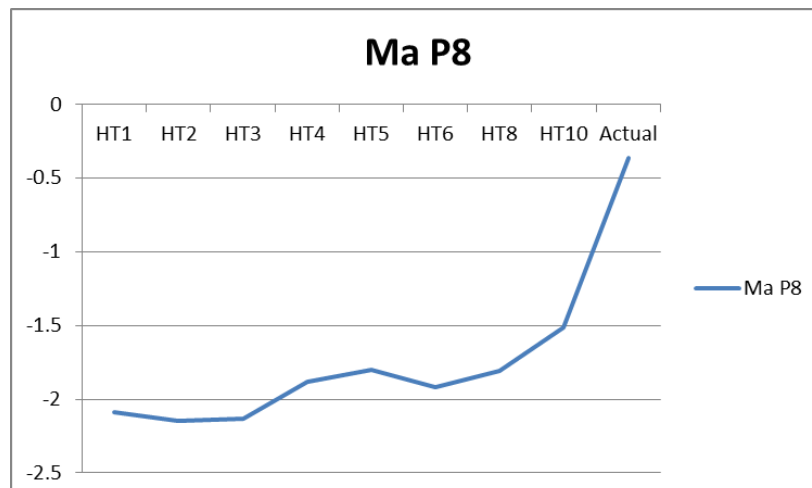
- (a) On average, students made over one grade's progress (1.36) in **English** during their time at Stephenson's Studio School.



- (b) 44% of the students achieved their FFT50 target in GCSE English, while 76% were within one grade of achieving it.
- (c) On the Access Pathway 82% of students achieved at least a Functional Skills L1 in English.

Mathematics

- (d) On average, students made almost two grades' progress (1.73) in **mathematics** during their time at Stephenson's Studio School.



- (e) 84% of all students made at least one grade's progress in mathematics from baseline assessment. 53% made at least two grades progress.

- (f) On the Access Pathway 45% students achieved at least a Functional Skills L1 in maths. 27% secured a Functional Skills L2 qualification.

Disadvantaged

- (a) 26% of DD students achieved a 4+ in English (with 1 receiving a grade 5 and 1 a grade 6).
- (b) 22% of DD students achieved a 4+ in maths (1 achieving a grade 5, 1 a grade 6 and 1 a grade 7).
- (c) 13% of DD students achieved a 4+ in science.

Post 16 Access Pathway

- (d) 5 students were on the Post 16 Access Pathway (formerly Step Into). Of these 4 secured a L2 Work Skills qualification (the one that did not, had already achieved a L2 BTEC Business award. 3 students achieved a L1 pass in Functional Skills English (60%), while 2 students achieved a L1 pass in maths (40%) in addition to qualifications that they had achieved in Y11.
- (e) 4 students have moved onto appropriate college places and the 5th has secured employment.
